If you are lucky, there is someone in your life who will inspire you to do more and be more. For Nancy Richardson, owner of Bar-T, that person was Shirley Kay, her high school guidance counselor. Shirley introduced Nancy to Hospice Caring and it wasn't long before Nancy realized why the organization meant so much to her mentor. Struck by the wonderful volunteers and staff, Nancy soon became involved, volunteering and eventually joining the board. Currently, she serves as the chair of Hospice Caring's Board of Directors and remains involved with Bar-T, although her son, Joe, has taken over day-to-day operations. A premier childcare provider, the company operates before and after school programming, summer camps, outdoor education, corporate team building, and events in Maryland and Virginia.

For Bar-T, the partnership with Camp Erin was a natural fit. Camp experts since 1984, they understood how important the relationships made at camp could be for a child. Many aspects of Camp Erin are the same as any other camp. Bar-T hosts Camp Erin at their Mountainside site, providing the campgrounds at no charge. Nancy's family and other Bar-T staff volunteer their time as Camp Erin Big Buddies, serving the 50 children who attend each year.

## Legacy Honoree: The Vilardo Family, in memory of Dick and Jody Vilardo

Dick and Jody Vilardo had a true love and by all accounts completed each other. With his vibrant personality, Dick truly wanted everyone around him to succeed. Jody's quiet strength and supportive nature were remarkable. Above all, the Vilardos cherished their family, including their two children, Katy and Andy.

On Mother's Day, May 10, 2015, Dick and Jody's lives were tragically cut short due to an act of violence. It's easy to let the tragedy overshadow the people affected, but the Vilardo children believed that their parents deserved more. Endlessly proud of their parents, they wanted to find a way to honor and preserve their legacy. They founded the Dick and Jody Vilardo Foundation to continue giving back to the community in their honor.

In 2017, they were drawn to Hospice Caring after learning about Camp Erin. Katy became a camp volunteer and felt an immediate connection to the mission and the children. She found the experience life changing and became even more involved in Hospice Caring. After undergoing additional training, she's ready to facilitate Good Grief Clubs, as well. The Vilardo Foundation is Hospice Caring's largest donor this year, supporting Camp Erin and other children's bereavement programs.

#### **AUCTION RULES**

#### The governing rules of the Hospice Caring Auction are as follows

All sales are final. No exchanges or refunds on auction items are permitted. Everything will be sold "as is." Please read carefully the specifications, restrictions, and limitations.

By his or her purchase, the buyer waives any claims for liability against either Hospice Caring, Inc. or the donor of the property or services, and neither Hospice Caring, Inc. nor the donor is responsible for any personal injuries or damages to property that may result from the utilization of property or services sold.

#### **AUCTION RULES CONTINUED**

Unless otherwise specified, all auction items and services must be used within the time frame set out in the guidelines of each item. Unless specified, dates and times are to be arranged at the mutual convenience of the donor and the buyer. Gift certificates are not redeemable for cash.

All auction items must be paid for in full, tonight, by cash, check, or credit card. Unless otherwise specified, no returns, refunds, or exchanges are allowed. All items are non-trans-ferable. We accept VISA, MC, AMEX, and Discover.

#### Silent Auction Rules

Items offered in the silent auction will have bid forms in front of each item. You may bid by simply writing your bid number on the form and the next increment you want to bid.

You do not have to take the next available bid amount. You may write in the amount you really want to bid that is higher than the next increment. The next bidder must bid a higher amount than your bid to be successful.

Most items offer a guaranteed purchase price, simply write your bid number on the "BUY IT NOW" line. The bidding on that item is then concluded and no one may bid above your guaranteed purchase bid.

You may bid on any item in any silent auction section until it is announced that the silent auction is closed or until 7:30 p.m., whichever is later. A silent auction official will circle the top bid number and amount at the completion of the auction. At checkout, if your bid number is listed among the successful bidder numbers, you may claim your auction items at the checkout counter after 10 p.m. To see if you have won, signs will be posted outside the ballroom doors.

Please allow our volunteers the time they need to calculate all of the auction items. We want to ensure accuracy and the time allotted is necessary to do so. Please do not remove auction items from the tables. Items will be available at auction checkout after 10 p.m.

#### **Live Auction Rules**

The live auction will take place during the dinner and continue without interruption until all items have been purchased.

Bidders remain seated. To enter a bid, the bidder raises his/her bid number, thus directing a signal to the auctioneer or to the spotter, whose job it is to relay bids to the auctioneer.

The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer shall be the purchaser. In the event of any dispute between two bidders, the auctioneer shall have the sole and final discretion either to determine the successful bidder or to re-offer the item in dispute.

If the auctioneer determines that an opening bid is not commensurate with the value of the article offered, he may reject the same and withdraw the item from the sale.

On the "fall of the auctioneer's hammer," title to the item will pass to the highest bidder.

#### About Us

Founded in 1989, Hospice Caring, Inc. is a volunteer-based, nonprofit organization that provides companionship and practical support for Montgomery County residents with serious illnesses and their families, as well as emotional support for anyone grieving the death of a loved one.

Our small staff and 300 + volunteers provide non-medical services, free-of-charge, none of which are covered by Medicare or other insurance. Our direct services are delivered by screened and trained volunteers, all of whom have completed at least three full days of specialized training.

Hospice Caring has been awarded the *Maryland Nonprofits Seal of Excellence* and has been named by the *Catalogue of Philanthropy* as one of the best small non-profit organizations in the Washington, DC area.

#### Our Mission

Hospice Caring provides caring, compassionate, practical and high-quality, non-medical support services, without charge, to Montgomery County adults and children facing a life-threatening illness or grieving the death of a loved one.

#### Our Vision

Hospice Caring envisions a community that accepts death as a part of life; where the processes of dying and grieving are embraced without stigma; where everyone has access to support services without charge; and where no patient dies alone and no one grieves without support.

#### Our Service Area

We serve all of Montgomery County, Maryland. The Volunteer Helping Hands program serves patients wherever they reside (private homes, assisted living facilities, nursing homes, etc). Bereavement groups and educational sessions are held in schools and other convenient locations throughout the community.

#### **Programs**

#### **Volunteer Helping Hands (Caregiving)**

Volunteer Helping Hands, Hospice Caring's patient and family program, offers short-term, practical, social and emotional support for people of all ages with a serious illness and no reasonable prospect of a cure.

Services include but are not limited to: companionship and emotional support, assistance with household tasks, respite care, patient advocacy, and limited transportation to appointments. Hospice Caring is licensed by the state of Maryland as a limited hospice care program. While we do not provide medical services, we supplement medical hospice and we also support patients who are still pursuing curative treatment.

#### **Bereavement Services**

Adult Support Groups

Bereavement support groups, facilitated by trained volunteers, allow participants to meet others who are also grieving, share their stories, and learn from one another. Specialized groups include adult child loss, parent loss, sibling or friend loss, spousal loss, and suicide loss. Additional groups are formed based on community need.

#### **Good Grief Clubs**

These seven-week support groups help children in grades K-12 explore their feelings, develop healthy coping strategies, and find comfort and safety in learning that they are not alone. These groups are facilitated by trained Hospice Caring volunteers in partnership with Montgomery County Schools, independent schools, and other community-based organizations.

Camp Erin© Montgomery County

This overnight weekend camp for grieving children is part of a national network of Camp Erin programs. It serves children and teens ages 6-17 and offers age-appropriate discussions and creative, fun-filled activities designed to help children share their feelings with peers who have had similar experiences. Camp Erin Montgomery County is a partnership between Hospice Caring, the Moyer Foundation, and Bar-T, a premier childcare provider.

**Family Nights** 

Hospice Caring's Family Nights are designed for families who have experienced the death of a loved one. Each workshop is held prior to a major holiday so families can learn coping tools, plan for how to handle celebrations, and mark the absence of their loved ones. Following activities, families are invited for dinner and to enjoy conversations with one another.

#### **Community Education**

Our Community Education program works to raise awareness and better equip people to address end-of-life and grief-related issues. We host an educational series called Seasons of Caring, teach lessons on loss and grief in schools, offer continuing education (CEU) workshops for professionals, and facilitate dialogue on relevant topics in the community.
